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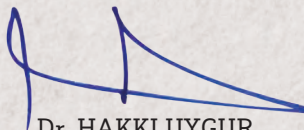

I hope our report will be a beneficial resource for you and your institution and I wish you a healthy, peaceful, and successful month with the hope of meeting again in the next issues.

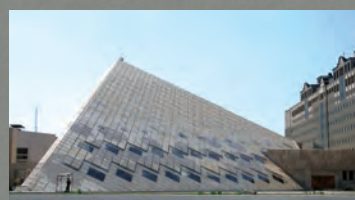
